



Malba, Museum of Latin American Art of Buenos Aires announces the 2025 call for the Writers Residence organized by its Literature department.

The Residence Programme offers an urban experience that allows contact with diverse cultural manifestations of the city. It also has an agenda of activities and events that take place annually in order to support cooperation among authors, managers, local publishers and guest writers to promote artistic collaboration.

**Duration:** 5 weeks

**Location:** Buenos Aires, Argentina

**Full grant for foreign writers.**

Grant for foreign writers, offering them the opportunity to stay 5 weeks in Buenos Aires as part of their professional and artistic development.

**Full grant for writers from Chile, Italy and Spain.**

This category is exclusively for authors of these nationalities who wish to live five weeks in Buenos Aires, as part of their artistic and professional development.

*Call for and selection of participants*

There is an annual Residence call in November, through the REM Website. Only applications in Spanish or English will be accepted. A specialized jury will examine the applications that have been shortlisted for the grant. The selected candidate will be announced in February 2025

*Applicant requirements*

- Authors willing to apply must have at least three published books (novel, short story, poetry, children's literature, literary non-fiction). Academic papers and self-published works will not be considered.
- To present a motivation letter and advance a concise and concrete plan to carry out during the stay.
- Argentine writers residing in other countries are excluded from selection.
- If not Spanish speaker, it is desirable (but not an exclusive condition) that the author has works translated into Spanish.
- The writer in residence is committed to dedicate his time in Buenos Aires to work on a manuscript.
- It is important that applicants could work independently and move around the city autonomously.
- Residents are invited to produce a short text (1.000 words) that can be published on Malba website.
- Residents may receive visitors but must travel unaccompanied.

*Benefits of the Residence*

- Airline tickets from and to their home city
- An apartment to develop their activities during their stay
- One stipend of USD 500 intended to contribute to various expenses for the duration of the programme (5 weeks).
- International travel insurance for the duration of their stay.
- Invited participants will have three encounters with general public (lectures, interviews) as a part of their residence activities.
- Malba Literatura will arrange for participants an agenda of activities with local figures and institutions, enabling participants to know the cultural activity in the city. Participation is optional.
- Malba Card that allows access to the activities programmed by the museum: exhibition halls, film and literature programs, and in the store and restaurant.
